Ireland: Thriving Economy with a Staffing Crisis

Ireland has the fastest growing economy in Europe with double digit GDP growth. The country is at 100% employment with a record number employed. However, a recent survey by the CIPD and the Kemmy Business School, found that 90% of businesses are facing significant staff shortages where over 50% highlighted front-line and operations staff as most in demand. The employers of Ireland are searching for staff that simply are not there.

EU Work and Study Program

The EU Work and Study Program combines General English 15-hours with career workshops, mentoring and a paid work placement. For students who would like more intensive English tuition we offer the option to include 5 hours Professional English or 5 hours Speaking Fluency to improve communication skills.

General English 15 Hours

General English 15-hour focuses on the four main skills while developing each student's individual grammar and vocabulary.

Speaking Fluency

Speaking Fluency is a level specific guided conversation class designed to improve communications skills for all contexts.

Professional English

Professional English is designed to improve business communication skills for students with intermediate level and above.

What type of jobs are available?

Many students will find jobs in hospitality in hotels, bars, and restaurants, or in retail working in shops and other tourism services. The first paid position in Ireland will be at **minimum wage which rises to €12.70 in January 2024**, with opportunities to secure better terms with experience or specialist skills. The role offered will often depend on the language ability with those with a higher level of English working in customer service and those with lower levels working in operations or back-office functions. There are opportunities for everyone with the right attitude.
